Priorities for 2015-2016

- Replenish and update PE equipment to support children in lessons.

Replenish and update PE equipment to support children in lessons.

Cost: £4,322.40

Impact

During the academic year 2015-2016, children have benefitted from updated equipment to use during PE lessons. This has focused particularly on invasion games and athletics, giving children the chance to experience these lessons with correct equipment. For example, children have been able to use shot puts instead of tennis balls, giving them a deeper understanding of the skills required to take part in such events. We have also invested in large gymnastic equipment to support the delivery of gymnastics in Spring 2017.

Cost: £172.00

Impact

School is now a member of the Association of Physical Education. This means the PE Co-ordinator can be kept up to date with new initiatives as well as having access to relevant training and CPD programs.

Upskill members of staff to support the delivery of PE in school

Level 5 Certificate in Primary Physical Education Specialism x 2

Cost: £350.00

Impact

During this year and the next academic year, two members of staff will undertake the Level 5 Certificate in Primary Physical Education Specialism. This will broaden the PE expertise in school enabling children to access well planned, delivered and supported PE lessons.

Purchase a team kit

Cost: £504.00

Impact

A team kit, comprising of navy joggers and hoodie (complete with school emblem) and gold round neck t-shirt have been purchased. Any child taking part in a school competition, such as the Brownlee Tri earlier this year, can wear a team kit. This will create a sense of belonging and team spirit.

Impact

The football club now have their own storage container and equipment. This means they no longer have to borrow from the PE equipment and can take ownership of their own belongings. Along with equipment they also purchased a 'Man of the Match' trophy and captain armband. Both of these items have helped developed children in to better players and given them a purpose for playing.

To support 'Sport Relief' this year, children took part in a Zumba session led by a qualified instructor. This was enjoyed by all children with everyone taking part. Children have requested a similar day to take place again for the next 'Sport Relief'.
