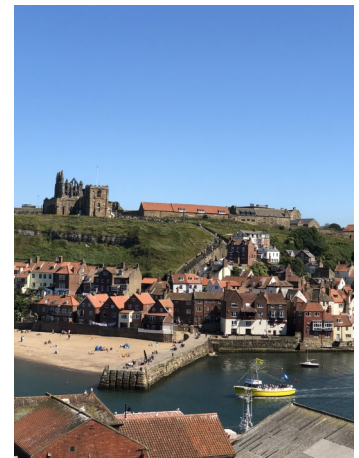

The bright sunshine was deceptive in its appearance as the cool breeze whipped off the North Sea causing the adults to shiver and the kids not to notice in the slightest.

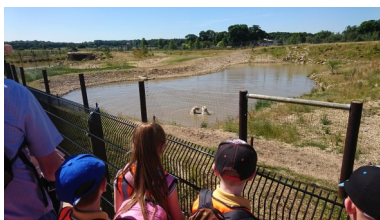
